**RSJ promises rip roaring show**

Australian-born singer Rebecca St James has pretty much done it all.

She's a singer, songwriter, author, actor, and conference speaker.

The Grammy award winning artist has millions of fans across the globe.

Now based in the US, her return to home soil is highly anticipated.

"You can expect a rip roaring show at Easterfest," Rebecca promises.

Previously known as the Australian Gospel Music Festival, Easterfest is a "massive" three-day event that takes over Toowoomba in Queensland each year during the Easter long-weekend.

Now in its 11th year, the festival is one of Australia's biggest drug and alcohol free events with more than 40 000 revellers cramming into Queens Park to witness more than 100 of the biggest names in international Christian rock, blues and gospel.

Moody says that while the music is one of the main reasons people come (and that's a big reason!), "the true purpose of Easterfest is to celebrate the Easter message and to remember the true origins of the holiday".
